



Bunny Slippers

Handmade, Warm and Cozy

TO GO – A Cabled Cup Cozy

Materials:

Approximately 25 yards worsted weight wool

4 5.0mm (US 8) double pointed needles

Cable Needle

Gauge/Measurements:

4 stitches=1 inch 6 rows= 1 inch

Finished piece should measure about 4 inches high and 6 inches in diameter.

Abbreviations:

K – Knit

P – Purl

CF6 – Move 6 stitches to a cable needle. Holding cable needle in front of the work, knit 6 stitches from working needle then knit the stitches from the cable needle.

Pattern:

Using 3 double pointed needles, cast-on a total of 32 stitches, 10 stitches on the first needle, 12 on the second needle, and 10 on the third needle.

Being careful not to twist the stitches, carefully join the round, and work like this:

First needle: P2, K4, P4 Second needle : K12 Third needle: P4, K4, P2

Repeat this round six more times, you will have completed 7 rounds.

Work the eighth round like this:

First needle: P2, K4, P4 Second needle : CF6 Third needle: P4, K4, P2

Work the ninth round just like the first:

First needle: P2, K4, P4 Second needle : K12 Third needle: P4, K4, P2

Repeat this round 10 more times, you will have completed 19 rounds.

Work the twentieth round just like the eighth:

First needle: P2, K4, P4 Second needle : CF6 Third needle: P4, K4, P2

Work the twenty-first round just like the first and the ninth:

First needle: P2, K4, P4 Second needle : K12 Third needle: P4, K4, P2

Repeat this round 5 more times, you will have completed 26 rounds.

Bind off all stitches loosely. Weave in your ends, get yourself a nice hot beverage, slip this on and enjoy!
